- Must be 18+ years old
- Must be a full-time student
- 2.5 minimum GPA
- All majors welcome
- Open to undergrad and grad students

How do I apply?

Submit the following via email to collaboratives@greenblue.org with the subject line: **[Your Name] Application for SPC Events Scholarship - SPC Advance 2026**

- A recommendation letter (from a professor or industry professional)
- A short essay (750 words max) or a 5-minute video answering:
 - *How has your background shaped your interest in sustainability?*
 - *What sustainable packaging or sustainability experience do you have (internships, research, etc.)?*
 - *Why sustainable packaging, and how does it align with your career goals?*

If selected as a finalist, students will be required to participate in a virtual interview. **Thank you for your interest as we aim to cultivate a new generation of leaders!**
